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What is Saṃskṛta?

Introduction to Upaveda-s:

In the previous newsletters we explored the Bhāratīya Jñāna Paramparā (IKS) framework, and details about Vedāṅga-s. In this newsletter let us get an introduction to Upaveda-s.

“Upa” means “near” or “associated”. Upaveda-s are often regarded as supplementary or associated texts to the four Veda-s.

The Upaveda-s present applied aspects of Vedic wisdom across various fields. The four Upaveda-s are Āyurveda (science of life), Dhanurveda (warfare), Gāndharvaveda (music and art) and Arthaśāstra (governance).

आयुर्वेदो धनुर्वेदो गान्धर्ववेदोऽर्थशास्त्रं चेति चत्वार उपवेदाः ।

Āyurveda (आयुर्वेदः):

Āyurveda is considered an Upaveda of the Ṛgveda and is traditionally attributed to Bhagavān Dhanvantari. This is one of the oldest systems of medicine in the world. It deals with the science of life and health, and its purpose is to promote longevity and well-being.

This consists of eight Sthāna-s as

1. **Sūtram** (Foundational principles)
2. **Śārīram** (physical aspects of the body)
3. **Aindriyam** (Sensory organs and diagnosis)
4. **Cikitsā** (Treatment methods)
5. **Nidānam** (Diagnosis)
6. **Vimānam** (Scientific examination)
7. **Vikalpaḥ** (Various treatment alternatives)
8. **Siddhiḥ** (Successful outcomes)

Holistic health: Āyurveda integrates śarīra, manas, and ātman, forming the foundation of preventive and promotive healthcare within IKS.

Āhāra–vihāra (diet and lifestyle): Emphasis on seasonal routines (dinacaryā and ṛtucaryā) and constitution-based regimens (doṣānurūpa āhāra–vihāra).

Tridoṣa–siddhānta (vāta, pitta, kapha): A core physiological theory influencing diagnostics and treatment strategies, even in contemporary integrative medicine.

Areas Being Explored

Dravyaguṇa vijñāna and rasaśāstra: Research into medicinal plants, minerals, and alchemical preparations has expanded, with applications in pharmacology and wellness products.

Clinical therapies: Widely practiced therapies across India and globally for detoxification and rejuvenation.

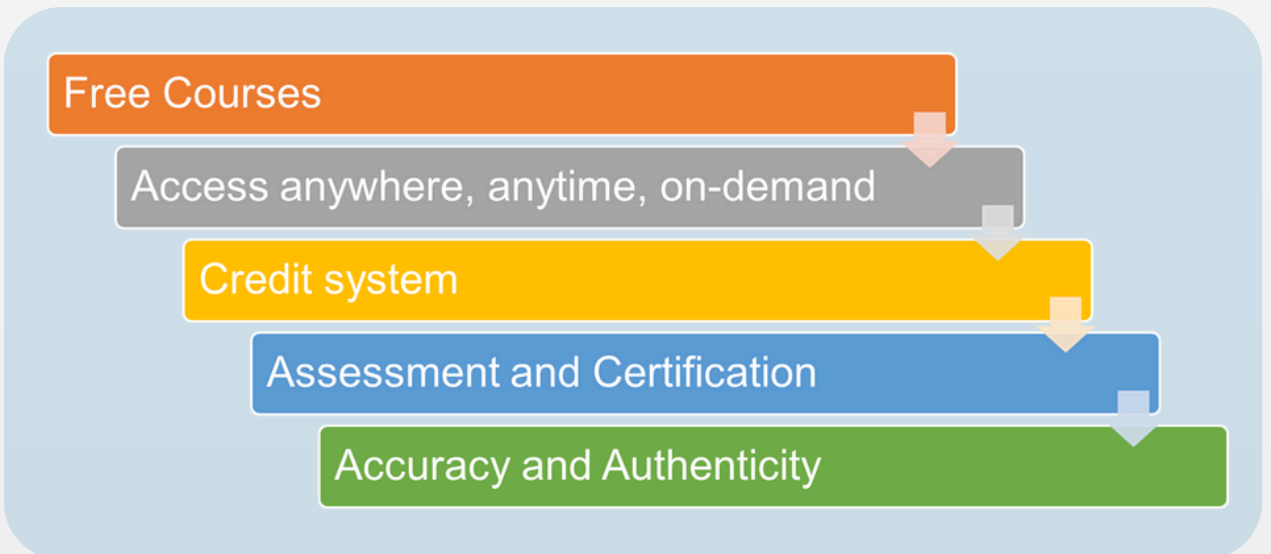

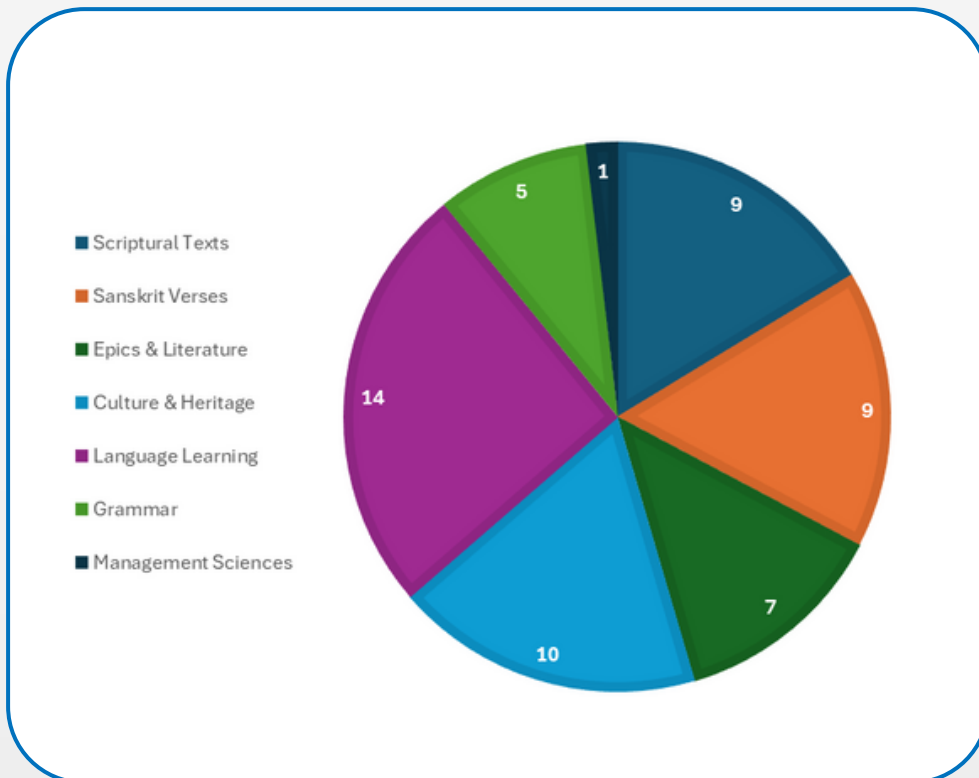

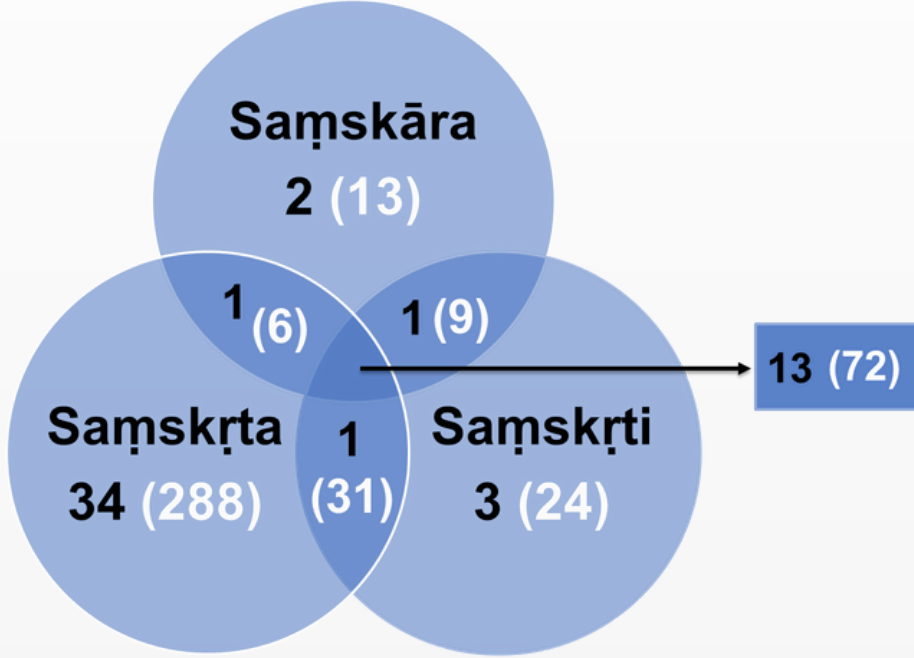
Subject-wise spread of courses

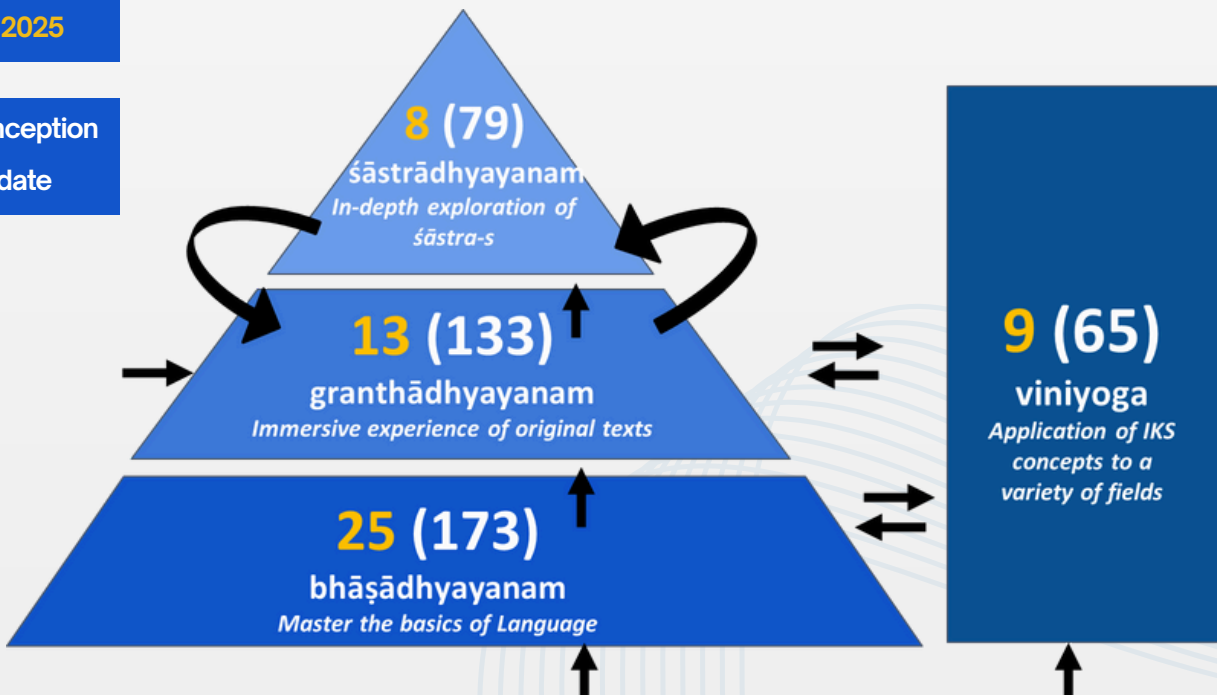

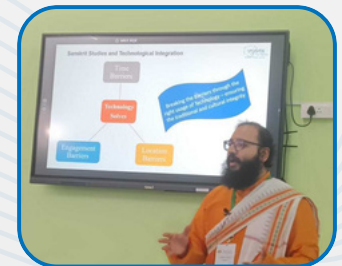
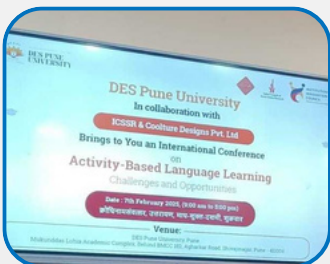


International Conference at DES PUNE University

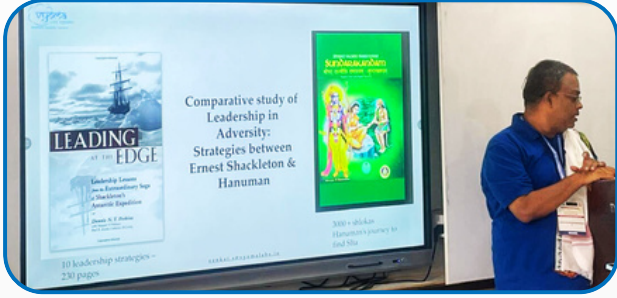

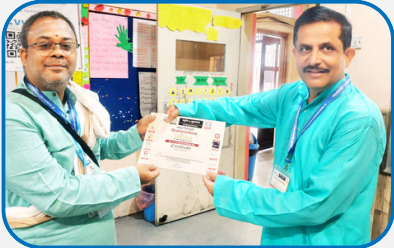

International Seminar on Indian Knowledge Systems

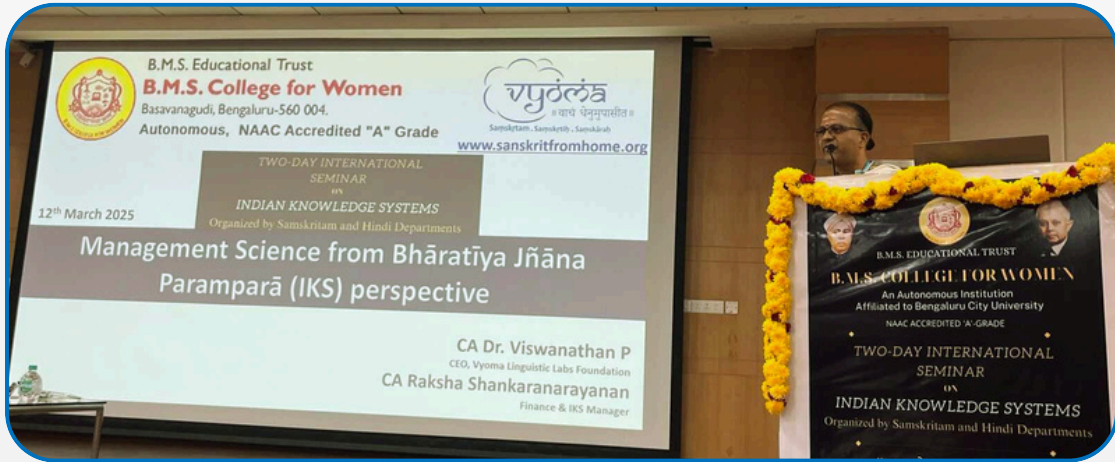

- Thought provoking future approach towards management sciences

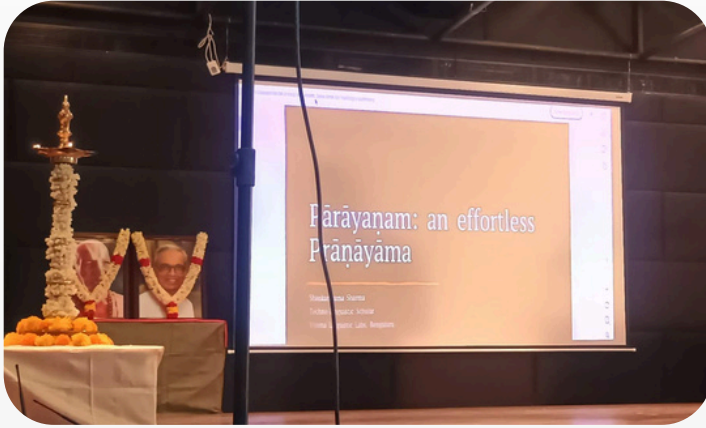

- Instruction in the recitation of the Subhāṣita-s

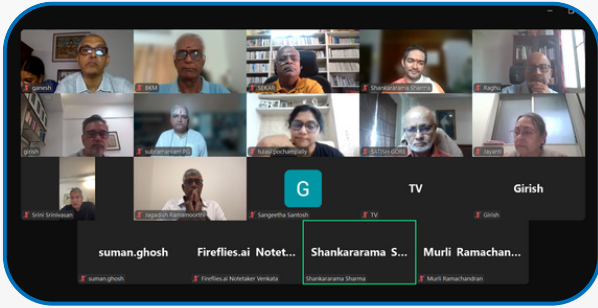

RTG Program at Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan – BBMP School

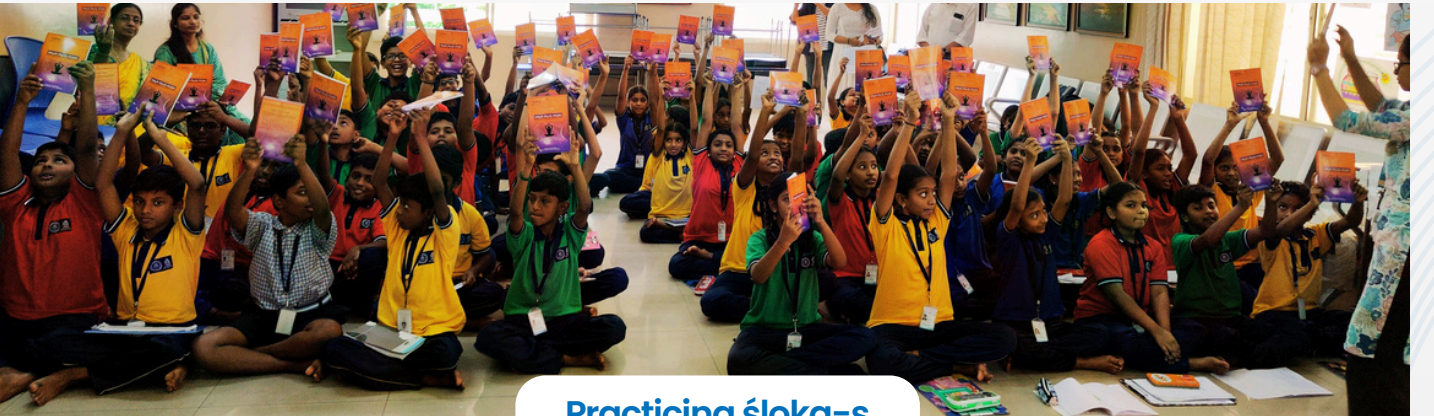

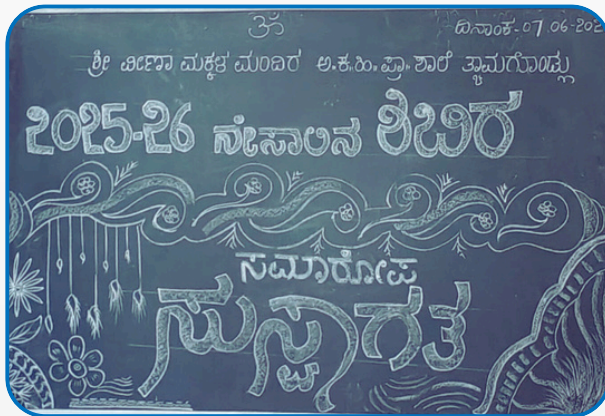

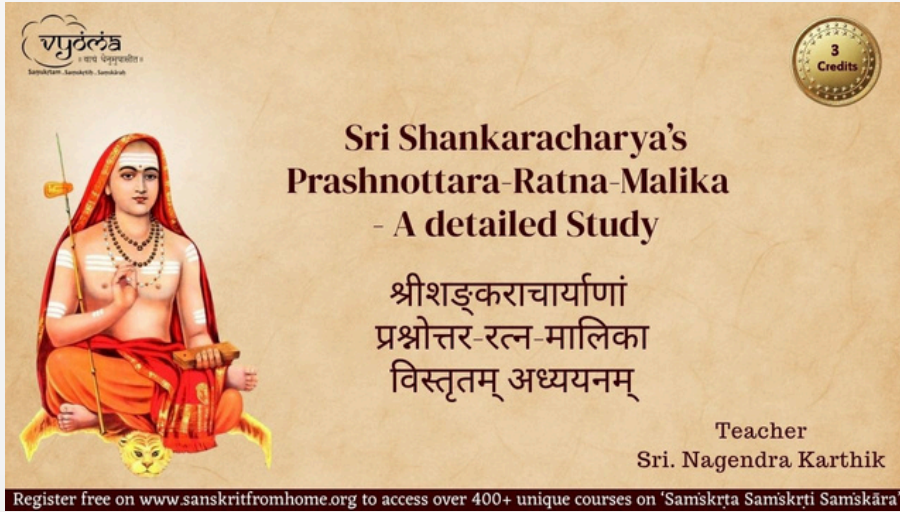

monumental work is usually done in several hours, while it is popularly chanted in smaller units of *daśakams* (10 *ślokas* each) in a total of 1036 verses, thereby making the memorising and recitation easy.

The beauty of *Srīmad Nārāyaṇeeyam* lies in the apt selection of words, the compact *samāsas* that succinctly convey the essence of the *puranas*, bringing the narratives to life and making the *pārāyaṇa* a compelling emotive experience.

The publishers of this book have done a yeoman service to those who have experienced the beauty of recitation of *Srīmad Narayaneeyam*, but would also want to know the meaning and nuances of the composition in English.

The first instalment of this book that covers the first 25 *daśakas* is designed to assist Sanskrit enthusiasts who

may embark on self-study. The book offers a step-by-step layout of the way to study the *ślokas* that would greatly help readers to derive maximum benefit from the contents.

Every *daśakam* is preceded by a lucid gist in English followed by *ślokas* and their explanations in *Samskr̥itam*. The *śloka* is first presented in bold print for ease of reading, with variant readings wherever necessary.

This is followed by meaning both in English and Sanskrit, showing clearly the *padavibhāga* (splitting of words) and the relevant *sandhi*. The *anvaya* (prose order) of the *śloka* is given and *pratipadārtha* (meaning of each word) is provided.

The editing of grammar portions by Smt. Sowmya Krishnapur, renowned for her expertise in *vyākaraṇa*, adds to the authenticity. The

book gives a comprehensive *pada parichaya* of the words in the *ślokas*.


The division of words into *kriyāpadas* (verbs), *nāmapadas* (nouns) and *avyaya-parichaya* (indeclinable words) facilitates easy comprehension. The *vyutpatti* (etymological derivation) of each word under *namapada* is done identifying *krdantas* or *taddhitāntas* and providing *vigraha vākyas* for *samāsas*.

In addition, the *kośa* is quoted and *upādī pratyayas* identified. Special grammatical peculiarities under these heads are also

explained, quoting the *Paṇinīya sūtra* that is in operation.

The book has an enlightening *āmukham* by Swami Ramanacharana Tirtha (popularly known as Sri Nochur Swamigal) in *Samskr̥itam*.

With due attention given to every aspect, this book is indeed valuable for learners of this immortal devotional hymn extolling the glory of Sri Guruvayurappan.
